This past Sunday, three young Asian ladies were baptized at our church. We have had the privilege of seeing them come to Christ and confess Him as Lord of their lives over the past months. What a joy!

When someone from another culture comes to America and trusts in Jesus it is a BIG deal and has many pieces. Some of those pieces are our church body, a loving, Bible-preaching pastor, our church's international student ministry monthly parties where they have been able to meet Christians, our Friday night Bible Studies and most of all, many prayers including yours. I'd like to share three students' God stories.

Miss F writes, "Dale and Marti guided me to know more about the New Testament and Jesus. They showed the "Jesus Film" in my language. To me, Jesus is not a cold leader, like many rulers in the world! He paid for our sins and never oppressed anyone. I didn't know that before. Many of my people don't know that from the past up to now. He did everything for us, for the people, not for himself, and died for us...I'll never forget that morning, March 18 last year at the gate of our Church. In the sunshine, Marti asked me: 'Miss F, are you ready for opening your heart and letting Jesus come into your heart to be with you?' 'Can I do this? I can't believe I can do this and I can't wait to do it.' I prayed after she guided me and I felt more and more peaceful and relaxed after that day."

Another one said, "After I decided to become a Christian, I wanted to follow God's words, love everyone, and give a hug to the world. Jesus Christ will give me love and support to express my love to others." And lastly, the third one said, "After I received Christ, I know God will guide everything right for me. Even when I face difficulties, I don't have as much fear as before."

These young ladies boldly stood in front of about 350 people, sharing their personal stories in a language that is not their mother tongue. Join us in giving glory to God!
