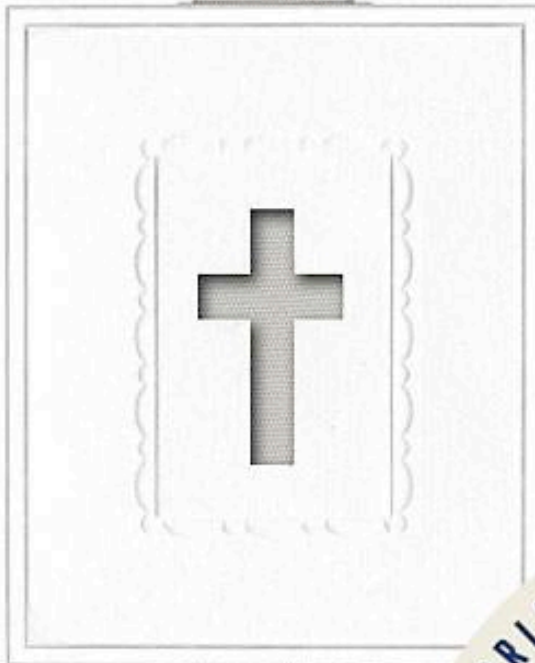


CONGRATULATIONS!
