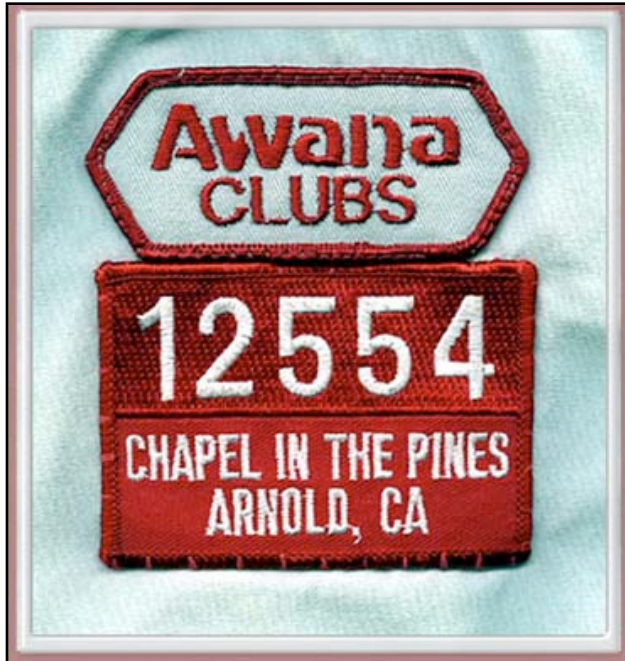

Truth & Training — Boys: boys in grades 3 through 6

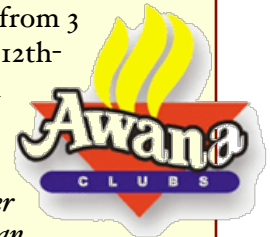
Truth & Training — Girls: girls in grades 3 through 6
