A Bald Eagle Named "Freedom" Nursed by a Cancer Fighter

Their story: Beginning in August 1998, Jeff Guidry and staff at Sarvey Wildlife Care Center in Washington, spent weeks tending to Freedom, a baby eagle who had been brought in emaciated, covered with lice, and with both wings broken. She was nursed back to health until Jeff developed stage-3 lymphoma. In 2008, Jeff penned the account reproduced on my web page, recounting his ten-year experience with Freedom and his own battle with cancer.
